

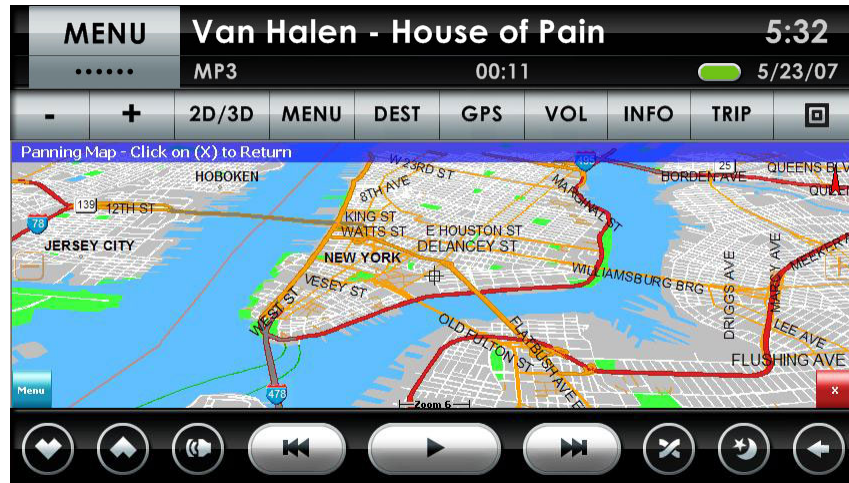
# CFiG (Centrafuse – iGuidance) Plug-In

## Plug-In Manual for Centrafuse™

## About

CFiG is designed to integrate iGuidance navigation software in a clean and simple skinnable plug-in for Centrafuse™.

## Installation of the plug-in

Open the file CFiG.msi and follow the instructions. When prompted for the install path make sure to enter the path of the Centrafuse install folder and not any subfolder or any other folder. For example, "C:\Program Files\Flux Media\Centrafuse".

## Configuration of the plug-in

Once the installation process is complete, start Centrafuse™ and navigate to settings. By default the settings button is on the third main screen, Use the arrows to navigate left or right until the SETTINGS button is shown. Press the SETTINGS button.



*SETTINGS button in Centrafuse™*

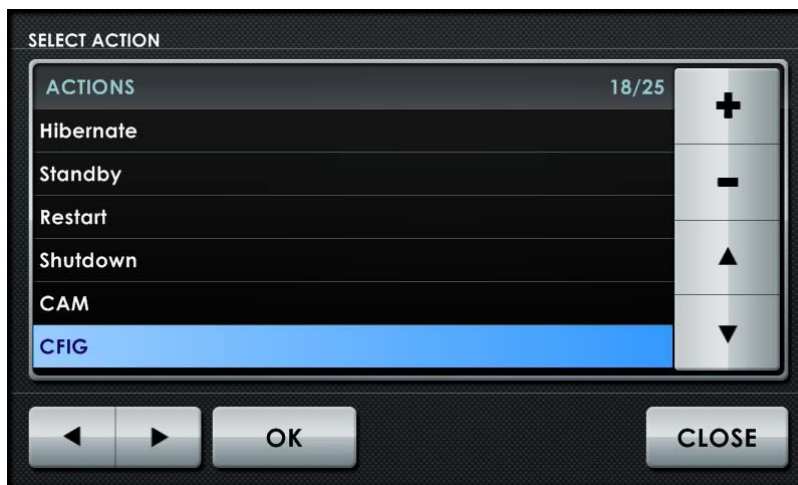
## Configuration (continued)

From the Settings menu, select BUTTON LAYOUT, press SETUP and you will see the screen below. Press up/down to locate the button that you want to assign to CFiG. Select the button and press SET.



*Choose a button, press SET*

Now you will see the Select Action screen. Press up/down until you locate the CFiG action. Select it as the action for the selected button and click OK. Once it is set, select CLOSE to return to the Centrafuse's Settings menu. Click CLOSE again to exit Settings.



*Assign CFiG plug-in as the Action to the selected button..*

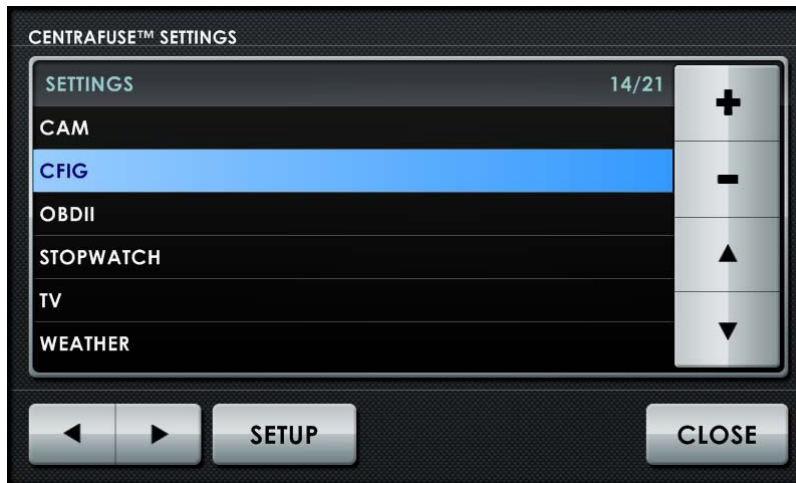
## Setup

Use the arrows to navigate left or right until the SETTINGS button is shown. Press the SETTINGS button.



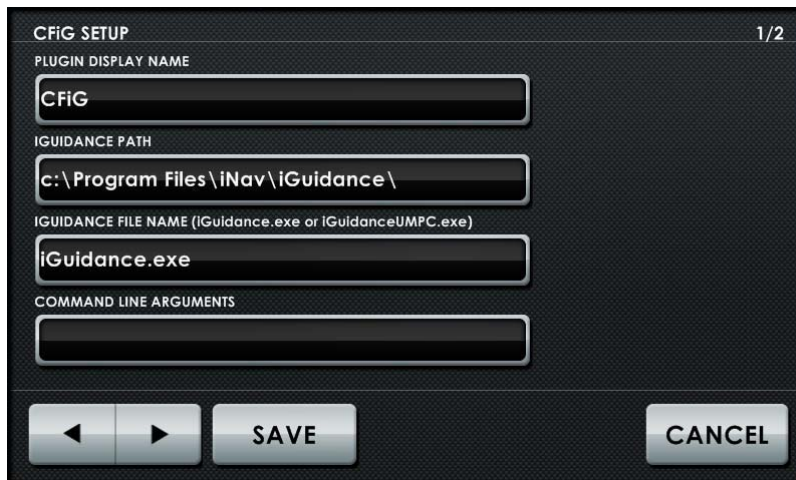
*SETTINGS button in Centrafuse™*

In Settings, press up/down to locate CFIG. Select it, and press SETUP.

This will open the Setup screen for the CFIG plug-in.

## CFiG Setup

The following is a list of setup options and descriptions of their use.

**PLUGIN DISPLAY NAME** – If you wish to change the name of the plug-in from the default of CFiG you can do so here. This will affect the name as it appears on buttons, menu and the plug-in title bar.

**IGUIDANCE PATH** – This is the path where you have installed iGuidance. The default installation path is shown; you should only have to modify this if you did not use the default path when installing iGuidance.

**IGUIDANCE FILE NAME** – The name of the iGuidance executable file in the path, above. For iGuidance version 3 there are two choices.

- iGuidance.exe
- iGuidanceUMPC.exe

The latter will start the Ultra Mobile PC version of the software.

**COMMAND LINE ARGUMENTS** – Use this line to have iGuidance loaded with any command line arguments. This is where you can add the nowarning parameter if the plug-in is being used in a non-moving demo or laws do not apply in your region/country. Neither Brian Gormanly nor Flux Media can be held liable for any modifications made using command line arguments with this plug-in.

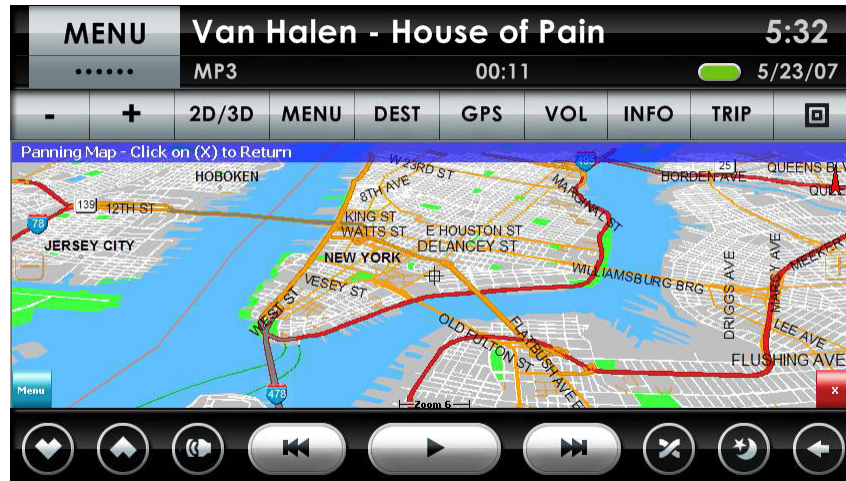
X OFFSET, Y OFFSET, WIDTH OFFSET, HEIGHT OFFSET – These control the placement of the iGuidance window within Centrafuse™. If there is a problem with the placement of the embedded window, use these controls to adjust. This might be necessary with modified / custom skins.

## Usage

You should see this button in Centrafuse's main menu. Click it to open CFiG.

### Buttons:

- Zoom map out
- + Zoom map in
- 2D / 3D change map view from 2-dimensional to 3-dimensional
- Menu – Open the iGuidance main menu
- Dest – Open the iGuidance destination menu
- GPS – Open the gps information window
- Vol – Open the iGuidance volume control window
- Info – Open the current location information window
- Trip – Open the trip information window
- Min / Max – Toggle plug-in size between regular and full-screen
