

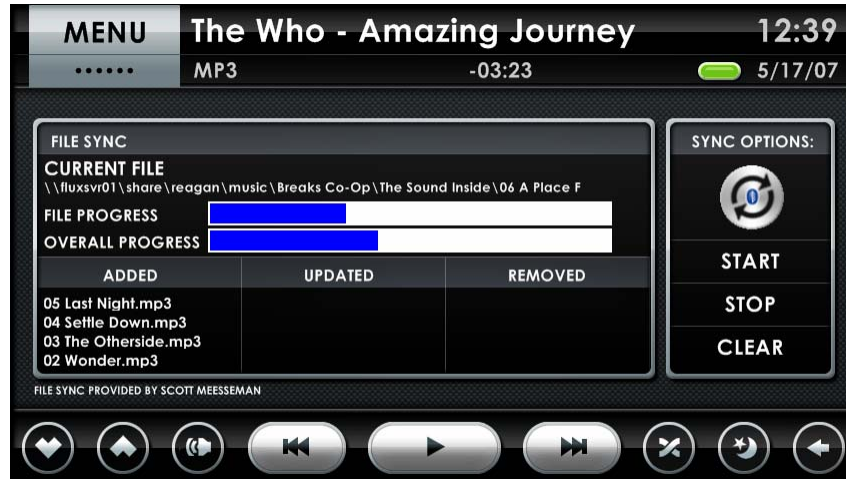
SyncFS Plug-In

Filesystem Sync Plug-In for Centrafuse™

About

SyncFS is a file system synchronization plug-in for Centrafuse. It will allow you to enter a local filepath where your media files are stored. Then you can enter as many remote media share filepaths as you like, separated by commas. Other options include automatic file removal and overwrite settings as well as file types to include, or exclude according to your needs. SyncFS also has settings for remote network connections.

Installation of the plug-in

Open the file CFSyncFS.msi and follow the instructions. When prompted for the install path be sure to enter the path of the Centrafuse install folder and not any subfolder or any other folder. For example, "*C:\Program Files\Flux Media\Centrafuse*".

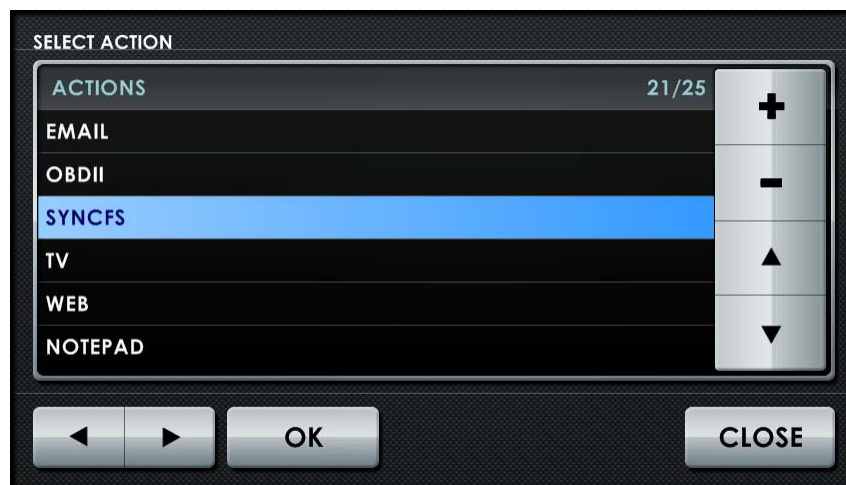
Installation (continued)

From the Settings menu, select BUTTON LAYOUT, press SETUP and you will see the screen below. Press up/down to locate the button that you want to assign to SyncFS. Select the button and press SET.



Choose a button, press SET

Now you will see the Select Action screen. Press up/down until you locate the SYNCFS action. Select it as the action for the selected button and click OK. Once it is set, select CLOSE to return to the Centrafuse Settings menu. Click CLOSE again to exit Settings.



Assign SyncFS plug-in as the Action to the selected button.

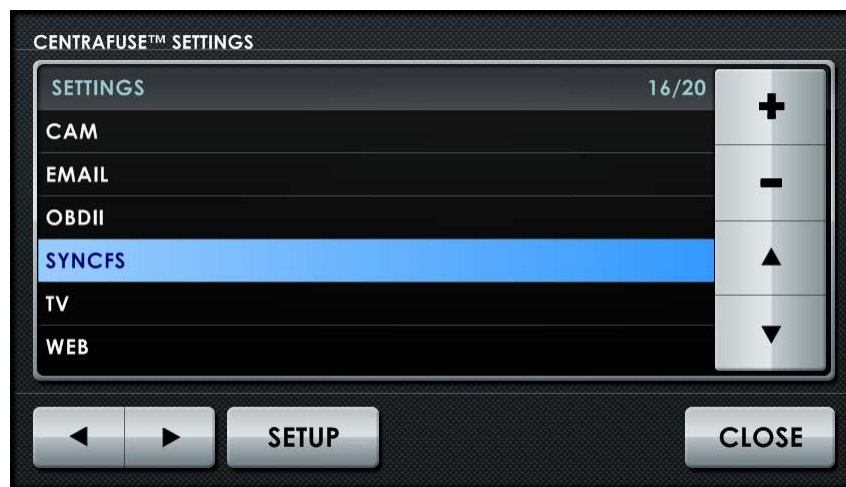
Setup

Use the arrows to navigate left or right until the SETTINGS button is shown.
Press the SETTINGS button.

In Settings, press up/down to locate SYNCFS. Select it, and press SETUP.

Setup (continued)

This will open the Setup screen for the SyncFS plug-in. Here you can change the display name for the plug-in, and setup your local and remote media filepaths.

This is page 2 of the SyncFS setup. Here you can add character patterns to ignore from the copy process. This overrides the "Character settings to sync" setting on page 1. The last 3 fields are for network authentication. Here you can enter your network username, password and domain if necessary.

Usage

You should now see this button in the Centrafuse main menu. Press it to open SyncFS.



SYNCFS button in Centrafuse™



- When you open SyncFS, you can see the control actions on the right under the text SYNC OPTIONS. Here you can Start or Stop the synchronization process, as well as Clear the status log in the bottom left.
- The left area of the SyncFS plug-in displays the current file being copied along with the progress of the current folder copy.
- When all remote file paths are finished synchronizing, the message SYNC FINISHED will appear to indicate completion.
