About

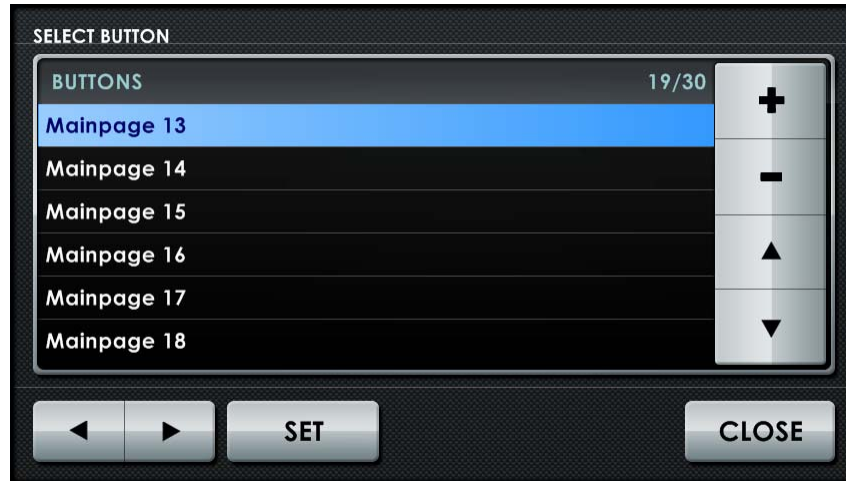
This is a Weather plug-in for Centrafuse. You can enter your city, postal code or location id and weather information will be downloaded for your region as it becomes available. *Note: This plug-in uses an internet connection to get weather data. If you're using a wireless account for internet access, ensure you have an appropriate data plan before installing this plug-in.*

Installation of the plug-in

Open the file CFWeather.msi and follow the instructions. When prompted for the install path make sure to enter the path of the Centrafuse install folder and not any subfolder or any other folder. For example, "C:\Program Files\Flux Media\Centrafuse".

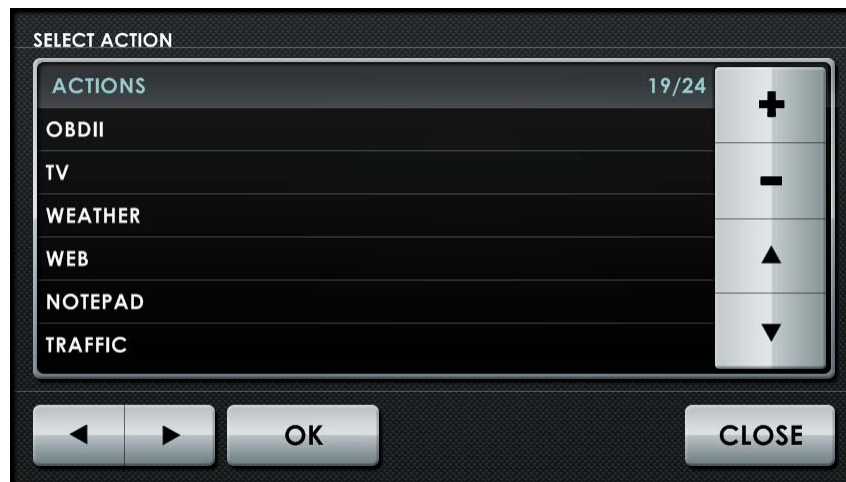
Installation (continued)

From the Settings menu, select BUTTON LAYOUT, press SETUP and you will see the screen below. Press up/down to locate the button that you want to assign to Weather. Select the button and press SET.



Choose a button, press SET

Now you will see the Select Action screen. Press up/down until you locate the WEATHER action. Select it as the action for the selected button and click OK. Once it is set, select CLOSE to return to the Centrafuse Settings menu. Click CLOSE again to exit Settings.



Assign Weather plug-in as the Action to the selected button.

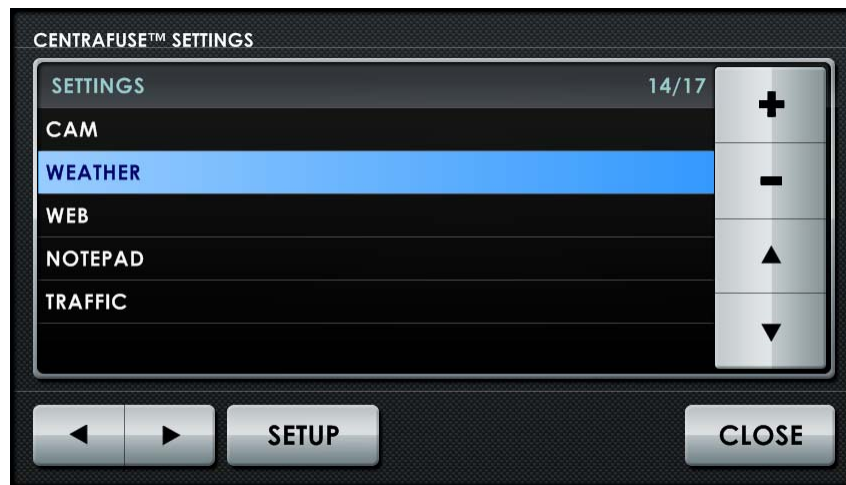
Setup

Use the arrows to navigate left or right until the SETTINGS button is shown.
Press the SETTINGS button.

In Settings, press up/down to locate WEATHER. Select it, and press SETUP.

This will open the Setup screen for the Weather plug-in. Here you can change the display name for the plug-in, and set your city, postal code or location id from weather.com.

Usage

You should see this button in the Centrafuse main menu. Press it to open Weather.

- When you open Weather, the left side shows the current conditions and 3 day forecast for your region, while the right side shows web links to other local weather reports.
- To change from degrees Fahrenheit to Celsius, simply change the standard settings from Imperial to Metric. This is found under SETTINGS on page 3 of the General settings page.
